FLOWER AREA

You should be getting near the tulip fields by now. Traffic could be heavy at times, so be patient. Sadly, many of the flowers have been harvested. Enjoy the scenery. The tulips grown in this area are sold locally as well as across the country. In recent years, we have seen several changes in the type of crops being grown. Blueberry fields are increasing, along with other berry crops. You can spot the blueberry fields by the reddish tone.

⇒ At signal, **go straight** (crossing Memorial Highway)

⇒ At stop sign, **right turn** onto McLean Road

While in flower area, you are allowed 30-45 minutes to explore the area and take pictures and shop. However, when you deviate from the route, make note of where you are so that you return to route and the next question or instructions. In other words, come back to where you left off.

⇒ **Left turn** onto Beavermarsh

⇒ At stop sign, **go straight** - still on Calhoun

⇒ At stop sign, **go straight** . . . **USE CAUTION** . . . Calhoun becomes Chilberg

⇒ At round-a-bout **go right** onto LaConner Whitney Road

⇒ At signal, **left turn** onto Highway 20
